



Awards

- Girls and boys collecting \$20 or more will receive a 4-H tee shirt.
- The boy and girl collecting the most money in each club (provided a minimum of \$20 is collected for King or Queen) will be designated club King and Queen. Each winner will receive a trophy at Achievement Day.
- The school winner who has the highest total amount of money for King and Queen respectively will be designated parish King and Queen. They will receive a large trophy plus a gift to be selected by the 4-H agents.

Remember: Money is due the day of your March 4-H club meeting.

Have you ever wanted to be King or Queen for a day?

If so, then make plans to take part in the annual 4-H Penny King and Queen Contest.

The rules are simple and the rewards are great! This is the annual fund-raiser for the 4-H program of Rapides Parish. The money is used to provide awards for parish contest such as Achievement Day, for special program, recognition of our volunteers, and recognition of outstanding 4-H club members.



All 4-H programs are open to members regardless of race, color, creed, sex, religion, national origin or handicap.

RULES

Who: 4-H members in grades 4-8

When: The contest begins the day of your January 4-H Club Meeting and ends the day of your March 4-H club meeting.

Note: All money turned in must be counted and all money converted to bills, check or a money order. **NO LOOSE CHANGE! Please!**

Each person turning in money will receive a receipt for the amount turned into the February club meeting and again at the March club meeting.

Important!!!

If a 4-H member forgets to bring his or her money to school on the deadline date, they have until 4:30 p.m. of that same day to bring it to the 4-H office to be eligible for competition.

If any money is turned in after the deadline date in the amount of \$20 or more, you will receive a tee shirt only; you will not be awarded the club king or queen. All money is to be turned in to your club leader or to your 4-H agent at the monthly club meeting.

All money must be counted and converted before turning it in!

Remember, money can be collected from January to March.

How: Prepare a container (unbreakable). Be sure to use one with a lid. Decorate it with the 4-H colors; include your full name, 4-H club (school) name, and the contest name. Cut a slot in lid for people to put in money. The more money you collect the better chance you have of being crowned King or Queen.

Example: \$.01 = 1 vote; \$.05 = votes; or \$1.00 = 100 votes. Whoever collects the most votes (money) is the winner. Each school can have one King and one Queen.

Where: The contest is conducted throughout Rapides Parish. Contact neighborhood business for permission to place containers in their store.

Ask friends, relatives and neighbors to contribute. **Collecting door-to-door is strictly prohibited.**
