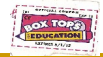


May Discovering St. Charles Parish

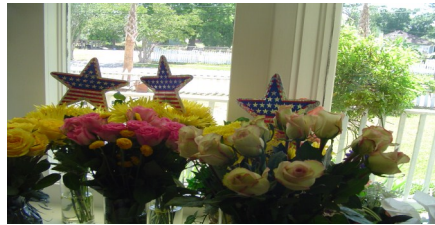
